ORDINANCE NO. 4126

AN ORDINANCE vacating a portion of N.E. 14th Street between 112th Avenue N.E. and I-405 in the City of Bellevue.

WHEREAS, a petition was filed with the City Council to vacate a portion of N.E. 14th Street between 112th Avenue N.E. and I-405 in the City of Bellevue; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has passed Resolution No. 4356 fixing the time and place for a hearing to consider the petition, and gave notice of said hearing by posting and mailing in the manner required by law; and

WHEREAS, investigation was made as to the use of said street and the public interest to be served or damaged by change of use or vacation thereof; and

WHEREAS, a hearing was held upon the said petition on the 2nd day of July, 1984, at the time and place fixed in said resolution and notice, as a result thereof, the City Council having found that the vacation of said street to the extent described would serve the public good, and no objections thereto being made by owners of private abutting property; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The following portion of N.E. 14th Street, to wit:

That portion of N.E. 14th Street in Burrows' East Side Addition, according to the plat recorded in Volume 44 of Plats, Pages 84-85, in the Records and Elections Division, in King County, Washington, described as follows: Beginning at the southwest corner of Lot 4 in said plat; thence South 88°25'29" East 400.82 feet along the south lines of Lots 16, 15, 14 and 13 in said plat to the west margin of Interstate 405; thence South 01°03'36" West 60.00 feet along said west margin to the north line of Lot 6 in said plat; thence North 88°25'29" West 400.87 feet along the north lines of Lots 6, 5, 4, 3 and 1 in said plat to the northwest corner of said Lot 1; thence North 01°06'10" East 60.00 feet to the point of beginning and containing 24,051 square feet, more or less,

is vacated.


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Section 2. The administration is hereby directed to record a certified copy of this ordinance with the records department of King County.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.




