CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 4137

AN ORDINANCE authorizing and directing acceptance of \$15,000 in King County Block Grant funds; amending the budget for Grant Control Fund No. 164 by appropriating such monies to that fund; and authorizing the City Manager to administer and expend said funds for the Merrywood School project.

WHEREAS, the City has allocated \$127,464 in 1988 and 1990 Bellevue Block Grant funds to support expansion of the current Merrywood School facility; and

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond has allocated \$15,000 in King County Block Grant funds to the Merrywood School project; and

WHEREAS, for purposes of administrative efficiency and to avoid duplication in managing these funds it is reasonable for Bellevue to manage all of said funds for the Merrywood School project; now therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designated representative is hereby authorized and directed to receive \$15,000 in King County Block Grant funds (City of Redmond) and to manage and expend same for the Merrywood School project in the same manner in which Bellevue Block Grant funds are managed and expended for said project.

Section 2. The City Manger or his designated representative shall have responsibility for the administration of said Block Grant monies and shall have all authority necessary to enter into and to amend agreements with King County and/or the City of Redmond and to take all other actions which may be necessary to carry out this project.

Section 3. The approximate amount and anticipated source of the revenue for said funds is:

King County Block Grant: \$15,000

Section 4. Upon receipt of said funds, the budget for Grant Control Fund No. 164 is hereby amended by appropriating to that fund anticipated revenues in excess of estimated revenue in the following amount:


Provided, however, if the actual funds received from the source specified should be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriation shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 5. The City Clerk is directed to transmit a certified copy of this ordinance to the Auditor of the State of Washington, Division of Municipal Corporations.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.




