CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 4145

AN ORDINANCE relating to penalties for violation of parking restrictions; increasing the monetary penalty for failure to respond to an infraction notice from ten to twenty-five dollars; and amending section 11.23.900 of the Bellevue City Code.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 11.23.900 of Chapter 11.23 of the Bellevue City Code, as last amended by Section 1 of Ordinance No. 3991, is amended to read as follows:

11.23.900 Penalties.

Failure to comply with any provision of this chapter is a traffic infraction.

- (A) Violators are required to respond within fifteen (15) days of the date of the issuance of the notice of infraction by:
 - (1) Paying a penalty of ten dollars (\$10.00) for each infraction cited on the infraction notice, or
 - (2) Requesting a hearing in the manner described in the notice of infraction.

- (B) Failure to respond to an infraction notice within fifteen (15) days of the date of the infraction shall result in:
 - (1) An additional monetary penalty of twenty-five (\$25.00) imposed as a default penalty for each parking infraction cited on the notice; and
 - (2) The loss of the right to a hearing on the parking infraction.


In addition, a criminal charge may be filed against the vehicle owner for failure to respond to a notice of infraction, and a hold may be placed on the renewal of the vehicle license for the vehicle involved in the violation.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days after final passage by the City Council.




