CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 4215

AN ORDINANCE relating to Bellevue City Code Chapter 9.11, Anti-Litter Code; amending Section 9.11.140 regarding violations; and repealing Bellevue City Code 9.11.150.

WHEREAS an efficient system is needed to enforce the provisions of this Chapter; and

WHEREAS the City of Bellevue has complied with the State Environmental Policy Act and the City's Environmental Procedures Code; now, therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Bellevue City Code 9.11.140 is amended as follows:

9.11.140 Violation - Penalty

A. The violation of or failure to comply with any provision of this chapter is declared to be unlawful.

B. Any violation of any provision of this chapter is a civil violation as provided for in Bellevue City Code Chapter 1.18, for which a monetary penalty may be assessed and abatement may be required as provided therein.

C. In addition to or as an alternative to any other penalty provided by this chapter or by law, any person who violates any provision of this chapter shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.


Section 2. Bellevue City Code Section 9.11.150 is repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days after its final passage.




