CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 4259

AN ORDINANCE relating to the 1991 Operating Budget; appropriating funds received in excess of estimated revenues; and amending the 1991 Operating Budget adopted pursuant to Ordinance No. 4200, as amended by Ordinances No. 4236, 4240, 4245 and 4253.

WHEREAS, the City Council has decided to adopt a new fee structure for environmental and land use development review fees; and

WHEREAS, staffing and other resources, must be provided to administer a new fee billing system; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Amendment of the General Fund (010) appropriations for the 1991 Operating Budget are summarized as follows:

The details of the budget changes adopted by this ordinance are set forth in that certain document entitled Attachment A, "Budget Detail", which has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 16637.

Section 2. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 4200, the 1991 Budget Ordinance, as amended by Ordinances No. 4236, 4240, 4245 and 4253 is hereby further amended by appropriating unanticipated revenue received during the current fiscal year to the General Fund, in the amount specified in Section 1 of this ordinance. The source of said funds is an environmental and land use development review fee increase which was not anticipated in the 1991 General Fund budget.


Section 3. The City Clerk is directed to transmit a certified copy of this ordinance to the Auditor of the State of Washington, Division of Municipal Corporations.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.




