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## CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 4300

AN ORDINANCE revising the existing Residential Permit Parking Zone 3 in the area surrounding Bellevue High School from "2-Hour Parking, 7am-4pm, Monday-Friday, Except by Permit," to "1-Hour Parking, 7am-4pm, Monday-Friday, Except by Permit; and amending Section 1 of Ordinance 4182 and BCC 11.23.720.

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 3935 creating a residential per parking zone, (Zone 3) in the area surrounding Bellevue High School; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 4042, the City Council expanded the residential parking zone created by Ordinance No. 3935 and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 4115, the City Council expanded the residential parking created by Ordinance No. 4042; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 4182, the City Council expanded the residential parking created by Ordinance No. 4115; and

WHEREAS, spillover parking from Bellevue High School is occurring and continuing to cause problems for people trying to access neighborhood residential streets, despite the current 2-hour parking restrictions; and

WHEREAS, the City Council concludes that reducing the amount of time a vehicle may park in the residential/permit parking zone (Zone 3) without a permit, will help address spillover parking problems and streamline parking enforcement procedures in that area; now therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 4182 and BCC 11.23.720 are hereby amended to read as follows:

11.23.720 Restricted Parking - Parking by Permit - Zone 3

- A. Parking of vehicles on the designated portions of the streets listed below shall be restricted to one-hour parking from 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., except Saturday, Sunday and holidays, except by permit issued under subsection B. below.

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- East side of the 200, 300, 600, 700, 800, 900 and 1000 blocks of 108th Ave. S.E. (minus 500, adjacent to the driveway access to Westwood Village).
- East side of the 300 block of 105th Avenue S.E.
- East side of the 400 block of 105th Avenue S.E.
- 200 block of 106th Avenue S.E.
- West side of the 300 block of 106th Avenue S.E. to 333
- 10600 block of S.E. 4th Street
- 1000 block of 107th Avenue S.E.
- 1000 block of 106th Avenue S.E.
- 10600 and 10700 block of S.E. 10th Street
- 1100 block of 107th Avenue S.E. (cul-de-sac)

- B. Parking restrictions established by Section 1 of this ordinance shall not apply to any vehicle parking on the streets enumerated in Section 1 above when said vehicle has a Zone 3 permit sticker or decal attached or affixed on or otherwise directly visible from the front or rear window of the vehicle.

Zone 3 permits may be issued by the Department of Public Works to any resident residing on any street enumerated in Section 1 herein for each vehicle owned by said resident. Visitor permits will be issued to said residents, with said visitor permits being transferable from one vehicle to another. Said visitors permits may also be borrowed or lent between residents. All Zone 3 permits will be issued pursuant to procedure established by the Department of Public Works which requires proof of residency and vehicle registration prior to issuance.


Section 2. The parking restrictions established by this ordinance shall be filed with and maintained by the City Clerk in accordance with Section 11.23.010 of the Bellevue City Code.

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Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect thirty days after final passage by the City Council.




