ORDINANCE NO. 4317

AN ORDINANCE vacating a portion of an alley at S.E. 5th Street and Burlington Northern Railroad.

WHEREAS, a petition was filed with the City Council to vacate a portion of an alley at S.E. 5th Street and Burlington Northern Railroad; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has Passed Resolution No. 4534 fixing the time and place for a hearing to consider the petition, and gave notice of said hearing by posting and mailing in the manner required by law; and

WHEREAS, investigation was made as to the use of said street and the public interest to be served or damaged by change of use or vacation thereof; and

WHEREAS, a hearing was held upon the said petition on the 28th day of May, 1985, at the time and place fixed in said resolution and notice, as a result thereof, the City Council having found that the vacation of said street to the extent described would serve the public good, and no objections thereto being made by owners of private abutting property; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The following portion of an alley - S.E. 5th and Burlington Northern Railroad, to wit:

A portion of a 16-foot-wide alley lying between Block 1 and Block 2 in Wilburton, as per plat recorded in Volume 11 of Plats, Page 97, in the Records and Elections Division, in King County, Washington, and lying east of the east margin of relocated S.E. 5th Street and lying west of the west line of the right-of-way of Burlington Northern Railroad and containing in said portion an area of 1,600 square feet, more or less

is vacated.

Section 2. The administration is hereby directed to record a certified copy of this ordinance with the records department of King County.


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Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.


