CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 4323

AN ORDINANCE regarding business licenses and regulations; and repealing Bellevue City Code Chapter 5.12, Private Security, and Ordinance No. 2200.

WHEREAS, in the 1991 legislative session the State Legislature adopted legislation concerning the licensing and regulation of private detectives (Chapter 328, Laws of 1991) and security guards (Chapter 339, Laws of 1991); and

WHEREAS, this legislation provides that such state licensing and regulation is exclusive, and that no governmental subdivision may engage in such licensing and regulation; and

WHEREAS, Bellevue City Code Chapter 5.12, adopted by Ordinance No. 2200, provides for such regulation and licensing, is now in conflict with state law, and should be repealed; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Bellevue City Code Chapter 5.12, and Ordinance No. 2200, are repealed.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days after passage by the City Council.




