## CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 4333

AN ORDINANCE transferring the authority of the Electrical Code Board of Appeals to the Building Code Board of Appeals; eliminating the Electrical Code Board of Appeals; amending Section 3.50.020 of the Bellevue City Code; and repealing Chapter 3.52 of the Bellevue City Code.

WHEREAS, as part of an effort to consolidate review processes, the City Council desires to eliminate the Electrical Code Board of Appeals and transfer all authority to hear Electrical Code appeals from the Electrical Code Board of Appeals to the Building Code Board of Appeals and, further, to transfer authority to hear Unfit Dwelling Code appeals to the Hearing Examiner; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue has complied with the State Environmental Policy Act and the City's Environmental Procedure Code; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Bellevue City Code Section 3.50.020 is amended as follows:

3.52.020 Purpose - Function and jurisdiction.

- A. The board shall hear all appeals from any notice or order issued, or any action taken, by any administrative officer of the city under the provisions of the following codes and ordinances:
1. Chapter 23.10 Uniform Building Codes,
  2. Chapter 23.50, Mechanical Code,
  3. Chapter 23.11, Uniform Fire Code,
  4. Chapter 23.30, Electrical Code,
  5. Any code or ordinance wherein it is provided that an appeal to the board shall be available.
- B. The board shall have jurisdiction and advisory authority to determine the suitability of alternate materials or alternate types of construction, if an alternate is contemplated or recognized by the express terms of the codes or ordinances of the city; and
- C. The board shall have authority to make recommendations to the city council for such new legislation as will expedite or improve the administration of such codes or ordinances; and
- D. The board shall have no authority to consider or determine any matter arising under the zoning or land use ordinances.

Section 2. Chapter 3.52 of the Bellevue City Code is repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days after passage by the city council.




