ORDINANCE NO. 4347

AN ORDINANCE providing for parking restrictions on the west side of 128th Avenue N.E. between N.E. 2nd Street and the entrance to Hyak School.

WHEREAS, parked cars are already interfering with pedestrian travel near the new Wilburton Hill Park; and

WHEREAS, the problems are expected to increase after the park opens; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized and directed to prohibit parking on the west side of 128th Avenue N.E. between N.E. 2nd Street and the entrance to Hyak School.

Section 2. The administration is hereby directed to record a certified copy of this ordinance with the Records Department of King County.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.

PASSED by the City Council this 13th day of April, 1992, and signed in authentication of its passage this 20th day of April, 1992.




