ORDINANCE NO. 4348

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the establishment of fees for play at the Bellevue Municipal Golf Course and repealing Ordinance No. 4011.

WHEREAS, it is a policy of the City to have the Municipal Golf Course be self-supporting; and

WHEREAS, golf course fees must be adjusted to cover increasing operating costs and needed capital improvements, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized to establish an increase of fees for play at the Bellevue Municipal Golf Course and amending Ordinance No. 4011, copies of which are attached hereto and has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 17679.
