ORDINANCE NO. 4379

AN ORDINANCE relating to the 1992 Operating Budget; appropriating funds received in excess of estimated revenues to pay for the anticipated costs of providing radon detection devices as required by state law; and amending the 1992 Operating Budget adopted pursuant to Ordinance No. 4311.

WHEREAS, the city Council has decided to adopt a new building permit fee to cover the costs of providing radon detection devices for single family homes the provision of which are required by Chapter 132, Laws of 1992; and

WHEREAS, resources must be provided to purchase these radon measuring devices and cover other costs; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Amendment of the General Fund (010) appropriations for the 1992 Operating Budget are summarized as follows:

Section 2. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 4311, the 1992 Budget Ordinance, is hereby amended by appropriating unanticipated revenue received during the current fiscal year to the General Fund, in the amount specified in Section 1 of this ordinance. The source of said funds is a building permit fee increase which was not anticipated in the 1992 General Fund budget.

Section 3. The City Clerk is directed to transmit a certified copy of this ordinance to the Auditor of the State of Washington, Division of Municipal Corporations.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.




