ORDINANCE NO. 4430

AN ORDINANCE relating to the establishment of a Residential Permit Parking Zone, with restrictions of one-hour parking 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m., except Saturday, Sunday and holidays, except by permit, on both sides of 111th Avenue N.E. north of N.E. 12th Street.

WHEREAS, residents along 111th Avenue N.E. have sent a petition to the City regarding parking spillover in their neighborhood by businesses from N.E. 12th Street resulting in the parking of vehicles for extended periods of time, creating an inconvenience to them and safety concerns; and

WHEREAS, City policy limits on-street parking in residential areas to the use of residents and their visitors; now, therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Parking of vehicles on both sides of 111th Ave. N.E., north of 12th Street shall be restricted to one-hour parking from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m., except Saturday, Sunday and holidays, except by permit issued pursuant to Section 3 of this ordinance.

Section 2. The parking restrictions established by Section 1 of this ordinance shall not apply to any vehicle parking on 111th Avenue N.E. north of 12th Street when said vehicle has a Zone 7 permit sticker or decal attached or affixed on or otherwise directly visible from the front or rear window of said vehicle, issued pursuant to Section 3 herein.

Section 3. Zone 7 permits may be issued by the Department of Public Works for each vehicle owned by any resident. Visitor permits will be issued to said residents, with said visitor permits being transferable from one vehicle to another. Said visitor permits may also be borrowed and lent between residents. All Zone 7 permits shall be issued pursuant to procedure established by the Department of Public Works which requires proof of residency and vehicle registration prior to issuance.

Section 4. The parking restrictions established by this ordinance shall be filed with and maintained by the City Clerk in accordance with Section 11.23.010 of the Bellevue City Code.
