CITY OF BELLEVUE

ORDINANCE NO. 4439

AN ORDINANCE providing for parking restrictions on the west side of 128th Avenue S.E. from S.E. 22nd Place to S.E. 32nd Street.

WHEREAS, 128th Avenue S.E. between S.E. 22nd Place and S.E. 32nd Street is a residential collector street with a largely unimproved shoulder on the east side and a paved shoulder/walkway on the west side which is delineated with an eight-inch fog line; and

WHEREAS, one purpose of the paved shoulder/walkway is to provide a safe walk route for Woodridge Elementary students; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works has received complaints of parking on the walkway since its completion in the fall of 1990; and

WHEREAS, the efforts of the Department of Public Works to educate residents as to the purpose of the shoulder/walkway, including working with the community association and posting flyers on offending vehicles, have failed to keep the walkway free of parked vehicles; and

WHEREAS, a parking restriction will help to prevent vehicles from parking in the shoulder/walkway, maintaining the shoulder/walkway areas for pedestrians; now therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Parking is prohibited on the west side of 128th Avenue S.E. from S.E. 22nd Place to S.E. 32nd Street.

Section 2. The administration is hereby directed to record a certified copy of this ordinance with the Records Department of King County and to post appropriate signs indicating the parking prohibition.



Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.


