

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 4450

AN ORDINANCE authorizing and directing acceptance of a Project Agreement grant for the Bellevue Police Department's Pedestrian Safety Project from the State of Washington Traffic Safety Commission, amending the budget for the Grant Control Fund by appropriating funds received in excess of estimated revenues to the fund; and authorizing expenditures of said grant funds.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby accepts, and the City Manager or his designated representative is hereby authorized and directed to accept, a Project Agreement grant from the State of Washington Traffic Safety Commission to the Bellevue Police Department, for a Pedestrian Safety project, in the amount of \$12,000.00 for the period October 1, 1992 through September 30, 1993. A copy of the Project Agreement grant has been assigned Clerk's Receiving No. 18538.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said Project Agreement grant.

Section 3. All of said monies shall be deposited in the Pedestrian Safety Project to be established within the Grant Control Fund.

Section 4. The City Manager or his designated representative shall have responsibility for the administration of said grant.

Section 5. The approximate amount and anticipated source of revenue for the grant herein accepted is as follows:

State of Washington Traffic Safety Commission \$12,000.00

Section 6. Upon execution an acceptance of said grant funds, the budget for the Grant Control Fund is hereby amended by appropriating to that fund anticipated revenues in excess of estimated revenue in the amount of the grant and acceptance herein authorized to the Grant Control Fund, currently anticipated in the following amount:

<u>Description</u>	<u>Amount Appropriated</u>
Pedestrian Safety Project	\$12,000

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Provided, however, if the actual revenues received from the anticipated source specified in said grant award should be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriation shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 7. The Finance Director or his designee is authorized to make interfund loans from the appropriate City fund to Grant Control in whatever amounts, for whatever duration and under whatever terms are appropriate and necessary to cover cash flow shortages in the Grant Control Fund that may be crated by this grant.

Section 8. The City Clerk is directed to transmit a certified copy of this ordinance to the Auditor of the State of Washington, Division of Municipal Corporations.

Section 9. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after passage and legal publication.


