CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 4454

AN ORDINANCE providing for revised water service and consumption charges, and repealing Ordinance No. 4244 effective January 1, 1993.

WHEREAS, the City of Seattle Water Department has increased wholesale rates to all purveyors buying water from the Seattle system, including a seasonal rate surcharge for summer water use effective January 1, 1992; and

WHEREAS, the Washington State Department of Ecology, King County and the recommendations in the East King County Coordinated Water Supply Plan (CWSP) all require the implementation of water conservation programs; and

WHEREAS, one significant element of a water conservation program is a rate pricing structure that encourages reduced consumption; and

WHEREAS, RCW 35.92.010 allows for the consideration of "the achievement of water conservation goals and the discouragement of wasteful water use practices" in setting water rates; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the public interest to provide for the following amended schedule of revised rates for water service and water consumption for the Waterworks Utility of the City of Bellevue and to comply with federal law and regulations; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Charges established - effective date. There are hereby established and shall be collected from each user of water service provided by the Waterworks Utility of the City of Bellevue water service and water consumption charges as hereinafter provided. The charges hereby established shall apply to water service provided on and after January 1, 1993 and shall supersede all existing schedules of charges as of said date.

Section 2. The meter service charge per bimonthly billing period for each user of water service shall be as follows:

Section 3. The water consumption charges per bimonthly billing period for each user of water service shall be as follows:

A. Single Family Residential

<u>Cubic Feet Consumed</u>	<u>Charge Per Hundred Cubic Feet of Water</u>
0 to 2,000	\$ 0.97
2,001 to 3,000	\$ 1.35
3,000 to 10,000	\$ 1.70
Over 10,000	\$ 3.00

B. Multifamily Residential Structure or Facility

1. A service charge of \$6.80 per dwelling unit, excepting one dwelling unit, plus

<u>Cubic Feet Consumed Per Dwelling Unit</u>	<u>Charge Per Hundred Cubic Feet of Water</u>
0 to 1,100	\$ 0.97
1,101 to 1,500	\$ 1.35
Over 1,500	\$ 1.70

3. For purposes of these charges, a "multifamily residential structure or facility" shall mean any residential structure or facility containing two or more dwelling units, including, but not limited to, duplexes, triplexes, apartment buildings, condominiums, trailer parks and parcels containing two or more separate dwelling units served through a single meter, but shall not include hotels or motels.

C. Irrigation meters or other meter arrangements that can be used for measuring water used strictly for outside irrigation.

<u>Cubic Feet Consumed</u>	<u>Charge Per Hundred Cubic Feet of Water</u>
All irrigation consumption	\$ 1.70

Provided that the total charges for single family irrigation charges under this provision plus the charges for single family domestic meter use under Sections 2, 3D and 6 shall not be less than would be charged under Sections 2, 3A and 6.

D. Non-irrigation meters where all irrigation consumption is charged under provisions of C above.

1. Single Family Residential

<u>Cubic Feet Consumed</u>	<u>Charge Per Hundred Cubic Feet of Water</u>
0 to 2,000	\$ 0.97
Over 2,000	\$ 1.35

2. Multifamily Residential Structure or Facility

<u>Cubic Feet Consumed</u>	<u>Charge Per Hundred Cubic Feet of Water</u>
0 to 1,100	\$ 0.97
Over 1,100	\$ 1.35

3. Non-Residential

<u>Cubic Feet Consumed</u>	<u>Charge Per Hundred Cubic Feet of Water</u>
All non-summer consumption	\$ 0.97
All summer consumption Where summer consumption is defined in Subsection E.2. below.	\$ 1.18

E. All users other than single family residential, multifamily residential, irrigation meters and non-irrigation meters, where both irrigation and non-irrigation consumption is measured through the same meter.

1. <u>Cubic Feet Consumed</u>	<u>Charge Per Hundred Cubic Feet of Water</u>
All non-summer consumption	\$ 0.97
All summer consumption	\$ 1.34

2. For purposes of these charges, summer consumption is that volume recorded on two normal bimonthly meter readings during the months of

July through October or readings during this period for other billing purposes, such as, but not limited to, customer changes.

Section 4. The service charge per bimonthly billing period for fire standby meters shall be as follows:

<u>Meter Size</u>	<u>Bimonthly Charge</u>
5/8" or 3/4"	\$ 5.41
1"	\$ 6.99
1-1/2"	\$ 9.11
2"	\$11.84
3"	\$15.21
4"	\$18.59
6"	\$28.73
8"	\$45.62
10"	\$62.51
12"	\$84.49

Section 5. The charges for each user outside the city or town limits of Bellevue, Clyde Hill, Hunts Point, Medina and Yarrow Point shall be the sum of the meter service charge in Section 2 plus the appropriate water consumption charge or charges in Section 3 plus a charge for fire standby meters in Section 4.

Section 6. The charges for each user inside the city or town limits of Bellevue, Clyde Hill, Hunts Point, Medina and Yarrow Point shall be the sum of the meter service charge in Section 2 plus the appropriate water service charge or charges in Section 3 plus a charge for fire standby meters in Section 4, all multiplied by the percentage indicated below for that city or town:

Section 7. If any section of this ordinance or any portion of any section of this ordinance, or its application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance or the application of the provision to other persons and circumstances, shall not be affected.



Section 9. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after passage and legal publication.


