CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 4461

AN ORDINANCE relating to taxation; levying a tax on the utilization of punchboards and pulltabs; providing for the use of the proceeds of such tax; amending Section 4.14.010 of the Bellevue City Code; and adding a new Section 4.14.025 to the Bellevue City Code.

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to tax the utilization of pulltabs and punchboards within the City of Bellevue and to apply the proceeds of such tax, to the extent allowed by state law, to youth facilities; and

WHEREAS, RCW 9.46.110 authorizes the City to levy a tax on the utilization of punchboards and pulltabs within the City at a rate not to exceed five percent (5%) of the gross receipts from such activities; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 4.14.010 of the Bellevue City Code, adopted pursuant to Ordinance No. 2118 (part) and as amended by Section 1 of Ordinance No. 2215 is further amended to read as follows:

4.14.010 Authority to levy tax.

In accordance with RCW 9.46.110, there is levied upon all persons, associations and organizations who have been duly licensed by the Washington State Gambling Commission:

A. To conduct or operate any bingo games, raffles and amusement games, a tax rate of ten percent of the gross revenue received therefrom less the amount paid for prizes or as prizes, except as otherwise exempted by Section 4.14.030;

B. For the conduct or operation on any premises or facility used to play social card games, a tax rate of one dollar per year for each member in the bona fide charitable or nonprofit organization to a maximum of one hundred dollars for each such premises or facility.

C. For the utilization of any punchboards or pulltabs, as defined by RCW 9.46.0273, a tax rate of five percent of the gross revenue received therefrom.

Section 2. A new Section 4.14.025 is hereby added to the Bellevue City Code to read as follows:


4.14.025 Proceeds from Tax on Punchboards and Pulltabs

All proceeds from the tax levied on the utilization of punchboards and pulltabs pursuant to BCC 4.14.010C, including any interest or other earnings thereon, shall, to the extent not required to enforce gambling activities pursuant to RCW 9.46.113, be used for the purpose of providing youth facilities; provided that nothing contained herein shall preclude the use of said funds for facilities that may also be used by other persons.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on January 1, 1993.


