ORDINANCE NO. 4489

AN ORDINANCE regarding the use of false identification to obtain liquor; and amending Section 11 (part) and Section 25 (part) of Ordinance No. 3516, and Bellevue City Code Section 10A.90.30.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 11 (part) and Section 25 (part) of Ordinance No. 3516, and Bellevue City Code Section 10A.90.030, are amended to read as follows:

It is unlawful for anyone knowingly to transfer any identification of age to a person under the age of twenty-one years for the purpose of permitting such person to obtain liquor or gain entrance to a tavern, or for such person, under twenty-one years of age, to use such identification or make false representations as to his age for the purpose of obtaining liquor or gaining entrance to a tavern.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days after enactment by the City Council.


