

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 4507

AN ORDINANCE relating to the parking of vehicles, establishing a Residential Permit Parking Zone (RPZ) and restricting parking on both sides of 110th Place S.E., south of Main Street, to "1 Hour Parking 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m., Except Saturday, Sunday and Holidays, Except by Zone 8 Permit."

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Parking of vehicles on the specified portion of the following street shall be restricted as follows:

Both sides of 110th Place S.E., south of Main Street, restricted to "1 Hour Parking 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m., Except Saturday, Sunday, and Holidays, Except by Zone 8 Permit."

Section 2. The parking restriction established by this ordinance shall be filed with and maintained by the City Clerk in accordance with Section 11.23.010 of the Bellevue City Code.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days after passage by the City Council.




