

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 4518

AN ORDINANCE authorizing and directing execution of a grant agreement with the Washington State Department of Transportation to accept federal grant funds for construction of a compressed natural gas (CNG) fueling station and conversion of a portion of the City's fleet to CNG.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designated representative is hereby authorized and directed to execute that certain Agreement with the Washington State Department of Transportation, given Clerk's Receiving No. 19047.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said Agreement.

Section 3. At the time of execution of said Agreement and acceptance of said funds, a project shall be established within the Grant Control Fund into which all said monies shall be deposited.

Section 4. The City Manager or his designated representative shall have responsibility for the administration of said grant monies and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 5. The approximate amount and anticipated source of revenue of the grant proposal and acceptance is:

Washington State Department of Transportation	\$561,000
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Section 6. Upon execution of said Agreement and acceptance of said funding, the budget for the Grant Control Fund shall be amended by appropriating to that fund anticipated revenue in excess of estimated revenue in the amount of the grant proposal and acceptance herein authorized, currently anticipated in the following amount:

City Vehicle Fuel Conversion	\$561,000
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Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the source specified in said Agreement should be more or less than the anticipated amount set

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forth herein, the appropriation shall be adjusted to be equal the amount actually received.

Section 7. The Finance Director or his authorized representative is authorized to make interfund loans from the appropriate City fund to the Grant Fund in whatever amounts, for whatever duration and under whatever terms are appropriate and necessary to cover cash flow shortages in the Grant Fund that may be created by this grant.

Section 8. The City Clerk is directed to transmit a certified copy of this ordinance to the Auditor of the State of Washington, Division of Municipal Corporations.

Section 9. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.
