ORDINANCE NO. 4538

AN ORDINANCE providing for parking restrictions on both sides of 110th Avenue N.E. from N.E. 4th Street to N.E. 12th Street and repealing certain sections of Ordinance No. 3296 and Ordinance No. 3430.

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works recommends a restriction of all parking due to concerns of consistency and operational safety on both sides of 110th Avenue N.E. from N.E. 4th Street to N.E. 12th Street; now therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Parking is prohibited on both sides of 110th Avenue NE from NE 4th Street to N.E. 12th Street.

Section 2. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 3296 relating to parking restrictions on 110th Avenue N.E. is hereby repealed.

Section 3. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 3430 relating to parking restrictions on 110th Avenue N.E. is hereby repealed.

Section 4. The administration is hereby directed to record a certified copy of this ordinance with the Records Department of King County and to post appropriate signs indicating the parking prohibition.




