ORDINANCE NO. 4546

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the City Manager to accept and execute a grant award agreement between the Washington State Department of Natural Resources (DNR) and the City of Bellevue for landscape enhancements along Forest Drive S.E.

WHEREAS, under the grant award agreement hereunder authorized, the Parks and Recreation Department will direct grant funds to small businesses for design, construction and maintenance of landscape improvements, because this agreement is under the Small Business Administration Appropriation Act of 1990, Public Law 101-515 which partially funds the landscape enhancement project.

WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue considers it in the best interest of the public to beautify this showcase boulevard to demonstrate the City's commitment towards enhancing urban environment.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to accept and execute a grant award agreement between the Washington State Department of Natural Resources (DNR) and the City of Bellevue for landscape enhancements along Forest Drive S. E., a copy of which Agreement has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 19202.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said grant award agreement.

Section 3. There shall be established at the time of execution and acceptance of said grant award agreement, a project within the Grant Control Fund, in which all of said monies shall be deposited.

Section 4. The City Manager or his designated representative shall have the responsibility for the administration of said grant monies and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 5. Upon acceptance and execution of said grant agreement, the budget for the Grant Control Fund is hereby amended by appropriating to that fund the amount of the grant and acceptance herein authorized to the Grant Control Fund, currently anticipated in the following amount:


