CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 4558

AN ORDINANCE providing for parking restrictions on the east side of 114th Avenue N.E. from 200 feet south of N.E. 4th Street to N.E. 6th Street and amending Ordinance No. 3590.

WHEREAS, Metro contacted Traffic Engineering regarding Bellevue Transit Center congestion which resulted in the operation of transit vehicles without passengers on city streets during layover periods, in turn resulting in waste of fuel, additional wear on vehicles, additional traffic congestion and air pollution; and

WHEREAS, Traffic Engineering identified the east side of 114th Avenue N.E. between approximately N.E. 4th Street and N.E. 6th Street as an area suited for use by Metro for the layover of transit vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Cabinet on July 7, 1993, decided the Metro layover area on 114th Avenue N.E. should be implemented; now therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Parking of vehicles on the east side of 114th Avenue N.E. from 200 feet south of N.E. 4th Street to N.E. 6th Street shall be restricted as follows:

"No Parking Anytime Except Metro Transit Vehicles"

Section 2. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 3590 relating to parking restrictions on 114th Avenue N.E. is hereby repealed.

Section 3. The administration is hereby directed to record a certified copy of this ordinance with the Records Department of King County and to post appropriate signs indicating the parking prohibition.
