CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 4574

AN ORDINANCE relating to the 1993 Operating Budget; appropriating funds received in excess of estimated revenues to pay for the community based policing/housing program; and authorizing the City Manager to enter into a contract with King County Housing Authority for the acceptance of funds for the Police Department's Community Based Policing Program within properties owned and managed by the King County Housing Authority.

WHEREAS, a high priority of the City Council of the City of Bellevue is the enhancement of the quality of life for Bellevue's families and youth; and

WHEREAS, assignment by the Police Department of a full-time officer to a sub-station office located in a group of apartment complexes owned and managed by the King County Housing Authority will work toward lowering crime rates and improving the living environment; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 2 of Ordinance 4459, the 1993 Budget Ordinance, as previously amended by Ordinance No 4484, is hereby further amended by appropriating previously unanticipated revenue to be received during the current fiscal year to the General Fund in the amount of \$25,000, as specified below. The source of said funds, which were not anticipated in the 1993 General Fund Budget along with the purposes for which they are being appropriated are specified in Attachment A to this ordinance entitled Community Based Low Income Housing Programs Appropriations.

Section 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with the King County Housing Authority for acceptance of funds to pay for the anticipated costs of providing services for the Police Department's Community Based Policing/Program, a copy of which Agreement has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 19547.

Section 3. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said agreement.

Section 4. The City Clerk is directed to transmit a certified copy of this ordinance to the Auditor of the State of Washington, Division of Municipal Corporations.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.


