

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 4579

AN ORDINANCE relating to admission tax; adding a new Section 4.04.160 to Chapter 4.04 of the Bellevue City Code to provide an appeal procedure.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A new Section 4.04.160 is hereby added to the Bellevue City Code to read as follows:

4.04.160 Appeals.

Any taxpayer aggrieved by the amount of the fee or tax determined by the clerk to be due under the provisions of this chapter may appeal such determination to the city hearing examiner in the manner and pursuant to the procedures set forth in BCC 4.08.220 for appeals under the business and occupation tax code.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.




