CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 4590

AN ORDINANCE adopting a proposed zoning regulation to become effective upon annexation of an approximately 42 acre parcel of unincorporated property located west of 128th Avenue S.E. and S.E. Newport Way, north of Coal Creek Parkway, east of 124th Avenue S.E. and south of approximately S.E. 42nd Street, commonly referred to as the Newport High School campus annexation area.

WHEREAS, RCW 35A.14.330 authorizes the City Council to adopt a proposed zoning regulation to become effective upon the annexation of any area that might reasonably be expected to be annexed by the City at any future time; and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that an approximately 42 acre parcel of unincorporated property located west of 128th Avenue S.E. and S.E. Newport Way, north of Coal Creek Parkway, east of 124th Avenue S.E. and south of approximately S.E. 42nd Street, commonly referred to as the Newport High School campus annexation area, may be annexed by the City in the near future; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 35A.14.340, public hearings were held by the City Council on December 7, 1992 and on October 18, 1993, at the hour of 8:00 p.m. pursuant to notice of said hearings published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City and in the area to be annexed and all interested parties appearing at said hearings and desiring to be heard in regard to the proposed zoning regulation having been heard by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, R-5 zoning for the Newport High School annexation area is deemed necessary by the Council to be in the best interest of the health, safety, and general welfare of the City and is consistent with the City's Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, all statutory requirements have been complied with, including those set forth in RCW 35A.14.330 and .340; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue has complied with the requirements of the State Environmental Policy Act and the City Environmental Procedures Code; now, therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

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Section 1. A proposed zoning regulation is hereby adopted establishing use classification R-5 for certain property located west of 128th Avenue S.E. and S.E. Newport Way, north of Coal Creek Parkway, east of 124th Avenue S.E. and south of approximately S.E. 42nd Street, commonly referred to as the Newport High School campus annexation area, and as more specifically described as:

That portion of the East half of Section 16, Township 24 North, Range 5 East, W.M., in King County, Washington, described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the Northeasterly margin of Coal Creek Parkway S.E. and the Easterly margin of 124th Avenue S.E.; thence Northerly along said Easterly margin to the North line of the South half of the North half of the Southwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of said Section 16; thence Easterly along said North line to the Westerly margin of 128th Avenue S.E.; thence Southerly along said Westerly margin to the North line of the South 200.00 feet of the North half of the Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of said Section 16; thence Westerly along said North line to the West line of East 230.00 feet of the Southwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of said Section 16; thence Southerly along said West line to the South line of the North half of the South half of the South half of the Northeast quarter of said Section 16; thence Easterly along said South line to the Southerly extension of the Easterly margin of 128th Avenue S.E.; thence Southerly along said Southerly extension to the Easterly margin of S.E. Newport Way; thence Southerly along said Easterly margin of S.E. Newport Way to the Northeasterly margin of Coal Creek Parkway S.E.; thence Northwesterly along said Northeasterly margin to the Point of Beginning.

Section 2. The proposed zoning regulation set forth in Section 1 of this ordinance shall become effective upon annexation to the City of Bellevue of the property described in Section 1 of this ordinance.

Section 3. A copy of this ordinance, duly certified as a true copy by the Clerk of the City, shall be filed with the County Auditor.

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Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.


