ORDINANCE NO. 4595

AN ORDINANCE amending the 1993-1999 Capital Investment Program by amending a project in the Plan; increasing the appropriation in the General CIP Fund to fund such amended project; and amending Sections 1 and 2 of Ordinance No. 4549.

WHEREAS, pursuant to interlocal agreement with King County approved pursuant to Resolution No. 5716, adopted by the City Council on November 15, 1993, the City of Bellevue agreed to assume lead agency status for the completion of the Lakemont Boulevard Extension project; and

WHEREAS, it is therefore necessary to amend the City's 1993-1999 Capital Investment Program Plan, adopted by Ordinance No. 4549 on July 19, 1993, in order to appropriate additional monies to the General CIP Fund for said amended project; now therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City's 1993-1999 Capital Investment Program Plan, adopted pursuant to Section 1 of Ordinance No. 4549 on July 19, 1993 and given Clerk's Receiving No. 19364, is hereby amended by revision of the following project as set forth in the attached CIP project description:

Lakemont Boulevard Extension

Section 2. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 4549, authorizing appropriations for the 1993-1999 Capital Investment Program Plan, is hereby amended by authorizing an additional appropriation of \$8,007,000 to the General CIP Fund to fund the revision of the Lakemont Boulevard Extension project as set forth in Section 1 of this ordinance.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.




