CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 4669

AN ORDINANCE authorizing execution of a contract with the Puget Sound Water Quality Authority to provide funding of water quality education efforts; amending the budget for the Grant Control Fund by appropriating monies received; and authorizing expenditure of such monies.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized and directed to execute on behalf of the City that certain Personal Service Contract between the City of Bellevue and the State of Washington Puget Sound Water Quality Authority for funding of water quality education efforts, a copy of which Contract has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 20626.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said Contract.

Section 3. There shall be established at the time of execution and acceptance of said Contract a project within the Grant Control Fund, in which all of said monies shall be deposited.

Section 4. Upon execution and acceptance of said Contract, the budget for the Grant Control Fund is hereby amended by appropriating to that fund unanticipated revenues in excess of estimated revenue in the amount of the grant contract and acceptance herein authorized to said fund, currently estimated in the following amount.

Section 5. The estimated amount and anticipated source of revenue for the project is as follows:

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received should be more or less than the estimated amount set forth herein, the appropriation shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 6. The City Clerk is directed to transmit a certified copy of this ordinance to the Auditor of the State of Washington, Division of Municipal Corporations.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.




