ORDINANCE NO. 4670

AN ORDINANCE of the City of Bellevue, Washington, repealing Ordinance No. 4365, passed by the City Council on June 1, 1992, ordering internal circulation improvements at Bel-Red Road and Northeast 20th Street and creating LID No. 286.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Bellevue passed Ordinance No. 4365 on June 1, 1992, which ordinance ordered the internal circulation improvements at Bel-Red Road and Northeast 20th Street and created Local Improvement District No. 286 to pay certain costs thereof; and

WHEREAS, the City Council gave notice to the property owners within LID 286 advising them that the City was considering cancelling LID 286; and

WHEREAS, affected property owners were afforded an opportunity to address the Council; and

WHEREAS, testimony at the hearing indicated and the Council finds that the property owners within LID 286 do not favor continuation of the project; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds that the public interest is no longer served by constructing the improvements originally contemplated for LID 286; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 4365, passed by the City Council on June 1, 1992, ordering internal circulation improvements at Bel-Red Road and Northeast 20th Streets and creating Local Improvement District No. 286 is hereby repealed.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.
