ORDINANCE NO. 4699

AN ORDINANCE authorizing and directing execution of a Memorandum of Understanding with Seattle-King County Department of Public Health to accept grant funds for the reimbursement of funds used for implementing hazardous waste reduction programs in accordance with the Local Hazardous Waste Management Plan for Seattle King County; establishing a project within the Grant Control Fund and appropriating previously unanticipated revenues to that project and fund; appropriating unanticipated revenues to the solid waste fund and authorizing expenditures of said funds; and authorizing interfund loans.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized and directed to execute that certain Memorandum of Understanding with Seattle-King County Department of Public Health to accept grant funds for the reimbursement of funds used for implementing hazardous waste reduction programs in accordance with the Local Hazardous Waste Management Plan for Seattle King County, a copy of which Memorandum of Understanding has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 20890.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive said monies and to expend the same as authorized in said Memorandum of Understanding.

Section 3. At the time of execution of said Memorandum of Understanding and acceptance of said funds, a project shall be established within the Grant Control Fund into which all said monies shall be deposited.

Section 4. The City Manager or his designated representative shall have responsibility for the administration of said grant monies and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 5. The approximate amount and source of revenue for the grant proposal and acceptance are:

Section 6. Upon execution of said Memorandum of Understanding the budget for the Grant Control Fund and for the Solid Waste Fund shall be amended by appropriating to those funds previously unanticipated revenues in the amount of the grant proposal and acceptance herein authorized.

Provided however, if the actual revenue received from the source specified in said Memorandum of Understanding should be more or less than the amount set forth herein, the appropriations shall be adjusted to equal the amount actually received.

Section 7. The Finance Director or his designee is authorized to make interfund loans from an appropriate City fund to the Grant Control Fund in whatever amounts, for whatever duration or under whatever terms are appropriate and necessary to cover cash flow shortages in the Grant Control Fund that may be created by this grant.

Section 8. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.


