CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 4707

AN ORDINANCE adopting the 1995 Housing and Community Development Plan, including the recommended uses for 1995 CDBG funds; authorizing and directing the submittal of a proposal to and acceptance of a grant award contract with the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development; creating a new project series within the Grant Control Fund; amending the budget for the Grant Control Fund by appropriating previously unanticipated revenues to that Fund; and authorizing the City Manager to enter into contracts with local human services agencies.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The 1995 Housing and Community Development Plan, including the recommended uses for 1995 CDBG funds, a copy of which has been attached hereto and has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 2095B, is hereby adopted.

Section 2. The City Manager or his designated representative is hereby authorized and directed to submit a proposal and to execute a grant award contract with the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development for the 1995 Community Development Block Grant Program.

Section 3. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend same as authorized in said grant award contract, including contracting with local human services agencies to provide community services.

Section 4. There shall be established at the time of execution and acceptance of said grant award, a project series within the Grant Control Fund to be known as the Community Development Block Grant, in which all of said monies shall be deposited.

Section 5. The City Manager or his designated representative shall have responsibility for the administration of said grant monies and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements with local human services agencies for the provision of community services in the amounts authorized by

the City Council pursuant to the 1995 Housing and Community Development Plan.

Section 6. The approximate amount and anticipated source of revenue for the grant proposal and acceptance is:

Department of Housing and Urban Development	\$640,000
Home Repair Loans Program Income	<u>30,000</u>
TOTAL	\$670,000

Section 7. Upon execution and acceptance of said grant award contract the budget for the Grant Control Fund shall be amended by appropriating to that fund previously unanticipated revenues in the amount of the grant proposal and acceptance herein authorized, currently estimated in the following amount:

<u>DESCRIPTION</u>	<u>AMOUNT APPROPRIATED</u>
Grant Control Fund Community Development Block Grant Program - 1995	\$670,000

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the source specified herein should be more or less than the estimated amount set forth herein, the appropriation shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 8. The Finance Director or his designee is authorized to make interfund loans from the appropriate City fund to the Grant Control Fund in whatever amounts, for whatever amounts, for whatever duration and under whatever terms are appropriate and necessary to cover cash flow shortages in the Grant Control Fund that may be created by this grant.

Section 9. The City Clerk is directed to transmit a certified copy of this Ordinance to the Auditor of the State of Washington, Division of Municipal Corporations.

Section 10. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.





SUMMARY OF
1995 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT
RECOMMENDATIONS

The Bellevue Human Services Commission has developed the following recommendations to the City Council on the City's use of anticipated 1995 Community Development Block Grant Funds from the federal Department of Housing and Urban Development. The Commission anticipates an award of \$640,000 from HUD and an additional \$30,000 from 1994 program income, for a total proposed expenditure plan of \$670,000.
