ORDINANCE NO. 4723

AN ORDINANCE relating to water service and consumption charges; and amending Section 6 of Ordinance No. 4614.

WHEREAS, the City Council approved Resolution No. 5828 authorizing franchise agreements with the City of Medina and the Towns of Clyde Hill, Hunts Point and Yarrow Point which include payment of franchise fees in lieu of utility taxes by the City of Bellevue Utilities serving these communities; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to provide for administrative adjustment of water charges based on any increase or decrease in such franchise fees; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 6 of Ordinance No. 4614 is amended to read as follows:

Section 6. The charges for each user inside the city or town limits of Bellevue, Clyde Hill, Hunts Point, Medina and Yarrow Point shall be the sum of the meter service charge in Section 2 plus the appropriate water consumption charge or charges in Section 3 plus a charge for fire standby meters in Section 4, all multiplied by the percentage indicated below for that city or town:

<u>City or Town</u>	<u>Percentage</u>
Bellevue	104.9740
Clyde Hill	111.7687
Hunts Point	107.3470
Medina	103.8263
Yarrow Point	105.5573

Provided that the percentages set forth above may be administratively adjusted by the Utilities Department Director to reflect any increase or decrease in any franchise fee required to be paid to such city or town by the Utility.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after passage and legal publication.


