CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 4725

AN ORDINANCE reducing the tax on collecting, hauling or transporting solid waste, including recyclables; amending Section 2 of Ordinance No. 1006, as most recently amended by Section 5 of Ordinance No. 2422, and Section 5.20.050 of the Bellevue City Code; and providing for a corresponding reduction in the rates charged customers pursuant to the City's agreement for solid waste, recyclables and yardwaste collection services with Eastside Disposal Service.

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to reduce the tax on collecting, hauling or transporting solid waste, including recyclables; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires that such tax reduction directly benefit City residents in the form of reduced rates charged customers pursuant to the City's agreement for solid waste, recyclables and yardwaste collection services with Eastside Disposal Service; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 1006, as most recently amended by Section 5 of Ordinance No. 2422, and Section 5.20.050 of the Bellevue City Code are amended to read as follows:

5.20.050 Levy of tax -- tax amount.

There is levied upon and shall be collected from every person, association or corporation engaging in the business of collecting, hauling and/or transporting of solid waste, including recyclables, within the City for disposal within or without the City, a tax for the privilege of doing so, such tax to be equal to 4.5 percent of the total gross income from customers within the City. Such tax shall be due and payable in quarterly installments, and remittance therefore shall be made on or before 45 days after the end of the quarterly period for which it is due. Sections 4.10.050, 4.10.100, 4.10.120, 4.10.130, 4.10.140, 4.10.150, 4.10.160, 4.10.170 and 4.10.180 of Chapter 4.10 of the Bellevue City Code shall apply with regard to the tax established hereunder as though fully set forth in this chapter.

Section 2. The City Manager is authorized and directed to execute an amendment to that certain Solid Waste, Recyclables and Yardwaste Collection Agreement with Eastside Disposal Service, a division of RABANCO COMPANIES, approved pursuant to Resolution No. 5763 on March 21, 1994 and given Clerk's Receiving No. 20254 in order to reduce the rates set forth therein in an amount corresponding to the reduction in tax set forth in Section 1 of this ordinance.

Section 3. Sections 1 and 2 of this ordinance shall take effect on January 1, 1995.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after passage and legal publication.


