ORDINANCE NO. 4810

AN ORDINANCE adopting the recommended uses for 1996 CDBG funds as transmitted by the Human Services Commission; authorizing and directing submittal of a proposal to and acceptance of a grant award contract with the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development; creating a new project series within the Grant Control Fund; amending the budget for the Grant Control Fund by appropriating previously unanticipated revenues to that Fund; and authorizing the City Manager to enter into contracts within local human services agencies.

WHEREAS, on September 28, 1995, the Bellevue Human Services Commission adopted expenditure recommendations for the anticipated 1996 federal Community Development Block Grant entitlement award from the Department of Housing and Urban Development,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designated representative, is hereby authorized and directed to submit a proposal and to execute a grant award contract with the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development for the 1996 Community Development Block Grant Program.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend same as authorized in said grant award contract, including contracting with local human services agencies to provide community services.

Section 3. There shall be established at the time of execution and acceptance of said grant award, a project series within the grant Control Fund, to be known as the Community Development Block Grant, in which all of said monies shall be deposited.

Section 4. The City Manager or his designated representative shall have responsibility for the administration of said grant monies and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements with local human services agencies for the provision of community services in the amount authorized by the City Council.

Section 5. The approximate amount and anticipated source of revenue for the grant proposal and acceptance is:

U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development	\$650,700

Section 6. Upon execution and acceptance of said grant award contract the budget for the Grant Control Fund shall be amended by appropriating to that fund previously unanticipated revenues in excess of estimated revenue in the amount of the grant proposal and acceptance herein authorized, currently estimated in the following amount:

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the source specified in said grant award should be more or less than the estimated amount set forth herein, the appropriation shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 7. The Finance Director or his designee is authorized to make interfund loans from the appropriate City fund to the Grant Control Fund in whatever amounts, for whatever duration and under whatever terms are appropriate and necessary to cover cash flow shortages in the Grant Control Fund that may be caused by this grant.

Section 8. The City Clerk is directed to transmit a certified copy of this Ordinance to the Auditor of the State of Washington, Division of Municipal Corporations.

AN ORDINANCE accepting the donation of certain real property consisting of 2.11 acres of open space located at 17601 S.E. Newport Way from William V. Lauman, Jr.


