

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 4856

AN ORDINANCE establishing the Law Enforcement Officers and Fire Fighters (LEOFF) I Medical Reserve Fund; specifying the purpose of the fund; establishing how said fund shall be administered; and appropriating anticipated revenues for such fund.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby established the "Law Enforcement Officers and Fire Fighters (LEOFF) I Medical Reserve Fund". The purpose of this fund is to provide a reserve for LEOFF I retiree medical costs.

Section 2. The Finance Department shall have the responsibility for the financial administration of the fund. The director of the department may establish rules and regulations for administration of the fund.

Section 3. There is hereby appropriated in the Law Enforcement Officers and Fire Fighters (LEOFF) I Medical Reserve Fund an initial appropriation of \$1,494,000, representing the initial 1996 General Fund contribution of \$1,422,000, plus estimated investment earnings of \$72,000.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.


