

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 4873

AN ORDINANCE authorizing and directing execution of a Memorandum of Understanding with the Seattle-King County Department of Public Health to accept grant reimbursement funds to implement household hazardous waste prevention and recycling projects in accordance with a prior agreement between the parties and consistent with the Local Hazardous Waste Management Plan; establishing a project within the Grant Control Fund by appropriating these grant revenues to the Grant Control Fund and to the Solid Waste Fund; authorizing expenditures of said funds; and authorizing interfund loans.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized and directed to execute that certain Memorandum of Understanding between the Seattle-King County Department of Public Health and the City of Bellevue for implementation of household hazardous waste prevention and recycling projects, a copy of which Memorandum of Understanding has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 23078. This Memorandum of Understanding authorizes the 1996 scope of work and funding under the Agreement between the City and Seattle-King County Department of Public Health approved by Ordinance No. 4766 and given Clerk's Receiving No. 21864.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said Memorandum of Understanding.

Section 3. At the time of execution of said Memorandum of Understanding and acceptance of said funds, a project shall be established within the Grant Control Fund into which all said monies shall be deposited.

Section 4. The City Manager or his designated representative shall have responsibility for the administration of said grant monies and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 5. The approximate amount and source of revenue for the grant proposal and acceptance are:

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Section 6. Upon execution of said Memorandum of Understanding the budget for the Grant Control Fund and the Solid Waste fund shall be amended by appropriating revenues in the amount of the grant proposal and acceptance herein authorized.

Provided however, if the actual revenue received from the source specified in said grant agreement should be more or less than the amount set forth herein, the appropriation shall be adjusted to equal the amount actually received.


Section 7. The Finance Director or his designee is authorized to make interfund loans from an appropriate City fund to the Grant Control Fund in whatever amounts, for whatever duration or under whatever terms are appropriate and necessary to cover cash flow shortages in the Grant Control Fund that may be created by this grant.

Section 8. The Finance Director or his designee is additionally authorized to make interfund loans from an appropriate City Fund to the Solid Waste Fund in whatever amounts, for whatever duration or under whatever terms are appropriate and necessary to cover cash flow shortages in the Solid Waste Fund that may result from making necessary program expenditures associated with this grant.

Section 9. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.




