ORDINANCE NO. 4879

AN ORDINANCE amending the 1995-2001 Capital Investment Program Plan by; amending projects in the Plan; adding two new projects to the Plan; increasing the appropriation in the General CIP Fund and Utility CIP Fund to fund the new and amended projects; and amending Sections 1 and 2 of Ordinance No. 4781.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the City's 1995-2001 Capital Investment Program Plan, adopted by Ordinance No. 4781 on July 17, 1995, in order to adjust the appropriation to the General CIP Fund and Utility CIP Fund for new and amended projects; now therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City's 1995-2001 Capital Investment Program Plan, adopted pursuant to Section 1 of Ordinance No. 4781 on July 17, 1995 and given Clerk's Receiving No. 22061, is hereby amended by amending certain projects and by adding the following projects, as more fully set forth in the CIP project descriptions and amendment detail, a copy of which has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 23136:

1. Weowna Park Renovation (P-R-24)
2. Performing Arts Center (CD-4)

Section 2. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 4781, authorizing appropriations for the 1995-2001 Capital Investment Program Plan, is hereby amended by authorizing an additional appropriation of \$3,519,000 to the General CIP Fund to recognize new grant awards, revised amounts for previous grant awards, additional contributions from other jurisdictions, land sale proceeds, contributions from other City funds, and miscellaneous revenue received from a bankruptcy settlement, and authorizing an additional appropriation of \$104,000 to the Utility CIP Fund to recognize a reduction in the amount of a Public Works Trust Fund Loan and the addition of a new grant award to fund the new and amended projects as set forth in Section 1 of this ordinance.
