

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 4908

AN ORDINANCE authorizing and directing execution of grant agreement amendments (and any additional amendments) with the Washington State Military Department to accept additional grant funds for emergency management purposes; establishing a project within the Grant Control Fund by appropriating previously unanticipated revenues to that fund; and authorizing expenditures of said grant funds.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized and directed to execute those certain Grant Agreement Amendments (and any additional amendments) with the Washington State Military Department to accept additional grant funds for emergency management purposes, a copy of which Agreements have been given Clerk's Receiving No. 23507 and Clerk's Receiving No. 23508.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said Agreements.

Section 3. At the time of execution of said Agreements and acceptance of said funds, a project shall be established within the Grant Control Fund into which all said monies shall be deposited.

Section 4. The City Manager or his designated representative shall have responsibility for the administration of said grant monies and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 5. The approximate amount and source of revenue for the grant proposal and acceptance are:

Washington State Military Department	\$22,757
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Section 6. Upon execution of said Agreements the budget for the Grant Control Fund shall be amended by appropriating to that fund previously unanticipated revenues in the amount of the grant proposal and acceptance herein authorized.


Provided however, if the actual revenue received from the source specified in said grant agreements should be more or less than the amount set forth herein, the appropriation shall be adjusted to equal the amount actually received.

Section 7. The Finance Director or his designee is authorized to make interfund loans from an appropriate City fund to the Grant Control Fund in whatever amounts, for whatever duration or under whatever terms are appropriate and necessary to cover cash flow shortages in the Grant Control Fund that may be created by this grant.

Section 8. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.


