ORDINANCE NO. 4912

AN ORDINANCE relating to the SR 520 project; authorizing the execution of: (1)an Interlocal Agreement with WSDOT for coordination of environmental review responsibilities for the Bel-Red Area Additional Access Project, CIP Project No. PW-I-48; (2) an Agreement with the State Transportation Improvement Board to accept grant funds to implement the Project, establishing a project within the Urban Arterial Trust Fund by appropriating previously unanticipated revenues to that fund, authorizing expenditures of said grant funds, and authorizing interfund loans; (3)an Agreement with Parsons, Brinckerhoff, Quade & Douglas, Inc. to provide environmental review services for the Project; and authorizing the Bellevue transportation Commission Chair to serve as a voting member of the Council-appointed SR 520 Citizen's Advisory Group.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized and directed to execute in substantially the same form that certain Interlocal Agreement with WSDOT for coordination of environmental review responsibilities for the Bel-Red Area Additional Access Project, CIP Project No. PW-I-48, a copy of which Agreement has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 23510.

Section 2. The City Manager or his designee is authorized and directed to execute that certain Grant Agreement (and any amendments, if necessary) with the State Transportation Improvement Board to accept grant funds to implement the Bel-Red Area Additional Access Project, CIP Project No. PW-I-48, a copy of which Agreement has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 23511.

Section 3. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said Agreement.

Section 4. At the time of execution of said Agreement and acceptance of said funds, a project shall be established within the Urban Arterial Trust Control Fund into which all said monies shall be deposited.

Section 5. The City Manager or his designated representative shall have responsibility for the administration of said grant monies and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 6. The approximate amount and source of revenue for the grant proposal and acceptance are:

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Section 7. Upon execution of said Agreement the budget for the Urban Arterial Trust Fund shall be amended by appropriating to that fund previously unanticipated revenues in the amount of the grant proposal and acceptance herein authorized.

Provided however, if the actual revenue received from the source specified in said grant agreement should be more or less than the amount set forth herein, the appropriation shall be adjusted to equal the amount actually received.

Section 8. The Finance Director or his designee is authorized to make interfund loans from an appropriate City fund to the Urban Arterial Trust Fund in whatever amounts, for whatever duration or under whatever terms are appropriate and necessary to cover cash flow shortages in the Urban Arterial Trust Fund that may be created by this grant.

Section 9. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to enter into that certain Agreement with Parsons, Brinckerhoff, Quade & Douglas, Inc. to provide environmental review services in the form of NEPA and SEPA documents for the Bel-Red Area Additional Access Project, CIP Project No. PW-I-48. a copy of which agreement has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 23512.

Section 10. The Bellevue Transportation Commission Chair is hereby authorized to serve as a voting member of the Council-appointed SR 520 Citizen's Advisory group.

Section 11. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.




