ORDINANCE NO. 4982

AN ORDINANCE amending Resolution No. 4928 and removing Residential Permit Parking Zone parking restrictions on selected streets in the Fairmont neighborhood.

WHEREAS, over the past ten years the City has maintained a Residential Permit Parking Zone in the Fairmont neighborhood to address spillover parking from Interlake High School; and

WHEREAS, a walkway connecting the Fairmont neighborhood to the school was closed several years ago, obviating the need for restricted parking on selected streets in the neighborhood; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 1 of Resolution No. 4928 pertaining to the establishment of a permanent residential permit parking zone in the Fairmont neighborhood is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. Parking of vehicles on both sides of the streets listed below shall be restricted to one-hour parking from 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. except Saturday, Sunday and holidays, except by permit issued pursuant to Section 2 of this ordinance:

NE 21st Place between 164th Avenue NE and 165th Place NE

Section 2. The parking restrictions established by this ordinance shall be filed with and maintained by the City Clerk in accordance with Section 11.23.010 of the Bellevue City Code.


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Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days after its passage and legal publication.




