CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 5036

AN ORDINANCE adopting the recommendations for the use of 1998 CDBG (Community Development Block Grant) funds as transmitted by the Human Services Commission; authorizing and directing submittal of a proposal to and acceptance of a grant award contract with the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development; creating a new project series within the Operating Grants and Donations Fund; amending the budget for the Operating Grants and Donations Fund by appropriating additional revenues to that Fund; and authorizing the City Manager to enter into contracts with local human services agencies.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The recommendations for the Bellevue Human Services Commission for the use of 1998 CDBG (Community Development Block Grant) funds, as set forth in the document given Clerk's Receiving No. 25017, are hereby adopted.

Section 2. The City Manager or his designee is authorized and directed to submit a proposal to and to execute a grant award contract with the United States Housing and Urban Development for the 1998 CDBG (Community Development Block Grant) Program.

Section 3. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said grant award contract.

Section 4. There shall be established at the time of execution and acceptance of said grant award contract, a project series within the Operating Grants and Donations Fund into which all said monies shall be deposited.

Section 5. The City Manager or his designated representative shall have responsibility for the administration of said grant monies and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements with local human services agencies for the provision of community services in the amount authorized by the City Council.

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Section 6. The approximate amount and source of revenue for the grant proposal and acceptance are:

Section 7. Upon execution of said Awards Contract the budget for the Grant Control Fund shall be amended by appropriating to that fund previously unanticipated revenues in the amount of the grant proposal and acceptance herein authorized.

Amount Appropriated

Operating Grants and Donations Fund and Urban Development 1998 CDBG (Community Development Block Grant)	\$ 730,000
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Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the source specified in said grant award or program income from the Home Repair Loans Repayment Income Program or other sources should be more or less than the estimated amount set forth herein, the appropriation shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 7. The Finance Director or his designee is authorized to make interfund loans from an appropriate City fund to the Operating Grants and Donations Fund in whatever amounts, for whatever duration or under whatever terms are appropriate and necessary to cover cash flow shortages in the Grant Control Fund that may be created by this grant.


Section 8. The City Clerk is directed to transmit a certified copy of this Ordinance to the State Auditor, Division of Municipal Corporations.

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Section 9. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.


