CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 5045

AN ORDINANCE authorizing and directing execution of modifications to an agreement with the federal Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms (ATF) to accept additional grant funds to support the continued operation of the task force known as Gang Resistance Education And Training; continuing a project within the Operating Grants and Donations Fund by appropriating such grant revenues to that fund; authorizing expenditure of said grant funds; and authorizing interfund loans.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized and directed to execute Modification One and Modification Two to that certain Cooperative Agreement No.97288132 between the City of Bellevue and Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms (ATF) to accept additional grant funds to support the continued operation of the task force known as Gang Resistance Education And Training (G.R.E.A.T.), a copy of which Agreement has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 24185. A copy of Modification One has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 25115 and a copy of Modification Two has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 25116.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said Modifications and Agreement.

Section 3. At the time of execution of said Modification One and Modification Two to Agreement and acceptance of said funds, that project established within the Operating Grants and Donations Fund into which all said monies have been deposited shall be continued.

Section 4. The City Manager or his designated representative shall have responsibility for the administration of said grant monies and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 5. The approximate amount and source of revenue for the grant proposal and acceptance are:

Section 6. Upon execution of said Agreement the budget for the Operating Grants and Donations Fund shall be amended by appropriating to that fund grant revenues in the amount of the grant proposal and acceptance herein authorized.


Provided however, if the actual revenue received from the anticipated source specified in said grant agreement should be more or less than the amount set forth herein, the appropriation shall be adjusted to equal the amount actually received.

Section 7. The Finance Director or his designee is authorized to make interfund loans from an appropriate City fund to the Operating Grants and Donations Fund in whatever amounts, for whatever duration or under whatever terms are appropriate and necessary to cover cash flow shortages in the Operating Grants and Donations Fund that may be created by this grant.

Section 8. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.


