

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 5134

AN ORDINANCE relating to the 1999-2000 biennial budget; amending the budget of the General Fund and the General Self-Insurance Fund; and establishing an effective date.

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 5111 on December 7, 1998 adopting the City's fiscal biennium budget for 1999-2000; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to appropriate General Fund resources above estimated levels to increase reserves in the General Self-Insurance Fund; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute the biennium budget of the City of Bellevue, Washington, for the years 1999-2000, as adopted by Ordinance No. 5111, is amended by adoption of the following adjustments to the estimated revenues and appropriations for the funds indicated:

General Fund	\$ 641,000
LEOFF I Medical Reserve Fund	\$ 641,000
Total 1999-2000 Budget Appropriation Adjustment	<u>\$1,282,000</u>

Section 2. The Clerk is directed to transmit a certified copy of this ordinance to the Office of the Auditor of the State of Washington, Division of Municipal Corporations and to the Association of Washington Cities.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.
