

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 5164

AN ORDINANCE authorizing and directing execution of a contract with the King Conservation District to accept special assessment funds for Kelsey Creek fish passage improvements and habitat restoration; establishing a project within the Grant Control Fund; appropriating additional revenues to the Grant Control Fund; authorizing expenditures of said funds; and authorizing interfund loans.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute that certain CONTRACT BETWEEN THE KING CONSERVATION DISTRICT and the CITY OF BELLEVUE to accept special assessment funds for Kelsey Creek fish passage and habitat restoration activities, a copy of which Contract has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 27709.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said Contract.

Section 3. At the time of execution of said Contract and acceptance of said funds, a project shall be established within the Grant Control Fund into which all said monies shall be deposited.

Section 4. The City Manager or his designated representative shall have responsibility for the administration of said Contract monies and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 5. The approximate amount and source of revenue for the Contract and acceptance is:

Section 6. Upon execution of said Contract the budget for the Grant Control Fund shall be amended by appropriating to that fund additional revenues in the amount of the contract and acceptance herein authorized.

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the source specified in said Contract should be more or less than the amount set forth herein, the appropriations shall be adjusted to equal the amount actually received.

Section 7. The Finance Director or his designee is authorized to make interfund loans from an appropriate City fund to the Grant Control Fund in whatever amounts, for whatever duration or under whatever terms are appropriate and necessary to cover cash flow shortages in the Grant Control Fund that may be created by this Contract.

Section 8. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.
