ORDINANCE NO. 5220

AN ORDINANCE amending the appropriation of the General CIP Fund by recognizing impact fee collections in excess of budget and amending the budget for CIP Plan No. PW-R-126, 110th Avenue NE Extension.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The General CIP Fund is hereby amended by appropriating thereto \$800,000 in development impact fees collected in the Downtown Mobility Management Area in excess of those previously budgeted.

Section 2. The budget for the 110th Avenue NE Extension project, CIP Plan No. PW-R-126 in the 1999-2005 CIP Plan adopted by Ordinance No. 5111, as amended by Ordinance No. 5215, is hereby increased by \$800,000 for a total project cost of \$3,116,000.

Section 3. The Clerk is directed to transmit a certified copy of this ordinance to the Office of the Auditor of the State of Washington, Division of Municipal Corporations and to the Association of Washington Cities.

Section 4. The ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.
