

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 5321

AN ORDINANCE implement hazardous waste prevention and education programs in accordance with the Local Hazardous Waste Management Plan (LHWMP); establishing a project within the Operating Grants and Donation Fund by appropriating unanticipated and future revenues to that fund; appropriating unanticipated revenues to the Solid Waste Fund and authorizing expenditures from said fund.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized and directed to execute that Agreement with the Seattle-King County Department of Public Health to accept grant reimbursement funds to implement hazardous waste prevention and education programs in accordance with the Local Hazardous Waste Management Plan (LHWMP), a copy of which Agreement has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 30942.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said Agreement.

Section 3. At the time of execution of said Agreement and acceptance of said Funds, projects shall be established within the Operating Grants and Donation Fund into which all said monies shall be deposited.

Section 4. The City Manager or his designated representative shall have responsibility for the administration of said grant monies and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 5. The approximate amount and source of revenue for the grant proposal and acceptance are:

Section 6. Upon execution of said Agreement the budget for the Operating Grants and Donation Fund shall be amended by appropriating to that fund revenues over and above those already appropriated in the amount of the grant proposal and acceptance herein authorized as follows:

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the source specified in said grant agreement should be more or less than the amount set forth herein, the appropriation shall be adjusted to equal the amount actually received.

Section 7. The Finance Director or his designee is authorized to make interfund loans from an appropriate City fund to the Operating Grants and Donation Fund in whatever amounts, for whatever duration or under whatever terms are appropriate and necessary to cover cash flow shortages in the Operating Grants and Donation Fund that may be created by these grants.

Section 8. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.
