

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 5336

AN ORDINANCE establishing Residential Permit Parking Zone 14 with No Parking 7am-4pm, Except Saturday, Sunday and Holidays, Except by Zone 14 Permit on both sides of 146th Avenue SE from 145th Place SE to SE 28th Street; 145th Avenue SE from SE 26th Street north to end of cul-de-sac; and SE 26th Street from 145th Place SE west to end of cul-de-sac.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby established Residential Permit Parking Zone 14 on both sides of the following portions of the following streets restricting said areas to "No Parking 7am-4pm, Except Saturday, Sunday and Holidays, Except by Zone 14 Permit":

- 146th Avenue SE from 145th Place SE to SE 28th Street.
- 145th Avenue SE from SE 26th Street north to end of cul-de-sac.
- SE 26th Street from 145th Place SE west to end of cul-de-sac.

Section 2. The parking restrictions established by this ordinance shall be filed with and maintained by the City Clerk in accordance with Section 11.23.010 of the Bellevue City Code.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days after its passage.
