

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 5353

AN ORDINANCE amending the 2001-2002 Biennial budget for the Housing Fund by increasing the appropriation and adjusting the authorized FTE levels.

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 5266 adopted on December 11, 2000, the City Council adopted a fiscal biennium budget for 2001-2002 for the Housing Fund; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to further amend the 2001-2002 biennium budget for the Housing Fund to provide for the addition of one Full Time Equivalent (FTE) Assistant Planner to be assigned to A Regional Housing Coalition (ARCH); now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The appropriation for the Housing Fund is increased as follows:

Housing Fund Appropriation,	\$4,572,004
Addition of One (1) FTE Assistant Planner:	<u>53,461</u>
Amended Housing Fund Appropriation:	\$4,625,465

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.
