

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 5362

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the City Manager or his designee to accept a grant award from the National Institute of Justice for improvements to Bellevue's Identification Laboratory; authorizing the expenditure of said grant funds; amending the budget of CIP Plan PS-40, Identification Laboratory Safety Improvements; amending the CIP Plan No. PS-40 by changing the project name to "Crime Laboratory Improvements" and revising the project description/scope; and authorizing an interfund loan to cover temporary cash flow shortages that may result from related grant activity.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute that certain Grant Agreement with the National Institute of Justice to accept a grant for equipment and renovation to Bellevue's crime laboratory, a copy of which has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 31785.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said Agreement.

Section 3. The project budget for CIP Plan No. PS-40 is amended by the addition of \$754,000 thereto, to create a total budget of \$1,044,000.

Section 4. The City Manager or his designated representative shall have responsibility for the administration of said grant monies and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 5. The approximate amount and anticipated source of revenue for the Agreement is:

NIJ	\$649,000
Facilities Fund	\$105,000

Section 6. Upon execution of said Agreement and the acceptance of said funding, the budget for the General CIP Fund shall be amended by appropriating to that fund anticipated revenue in excess of estimated revenue in the amount set forth in the Agreement herein authorized, currently anticipated in the following amount:

<u>Description</u>	<u>Amount Appropriated</u>
General CIP Fund	\$754,000

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the anticipated source specified in said Agreement should be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriation shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 7. The CIP Plan No. PS-40, Identification Laboratory Safety Improvements is amended to change the project name to "Crime Laboratory Improvements" and to revise the project description contained in the CIP Project Description - New which has been given Clerk's Receiving No. **31876**.

Section 8. The Finance Director or his designee is authorized to make interfund loans from the appropriate city fund to the CIP General Fund in whatever amounts for whatever duration or under whatever terms are appropriate and necessary to cover cash flow shortages in the CIP General Fund that may be created by this grant.

Section 9. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.
