

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON  
ORDINANCE NO. 5383

AN ORDINANCE assuming that portion of the Coal Creek Utility District lying within the corporate boundaries of the City of Bellevue as provided in the Settlement Agreement between the City of Bellevue and the Coal Creek Utility District.

WHEREAS, in 1995 the City began a process to assume that portion of the Coal Creek Utility District lying with the City; and

WHEREAS, in August 2000 the King County Boundary Review Board approved the proposed assumption; and

WHEREAS, the District and the City entered into a Settlement Agreement approved by Council on July 30, 2001, which provides that the City will assume the Coal Creek Utility District effective December 31, 2001; and

WHEREAS, RCW 35.13A provides that a city may assume, by ordinance, jurisdiction of a utility district's responsibilities, property, facilities and equipment within the corporate limits of the city; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Effective December 31, 2003 at 2:30 p.m., the City assumes that portion of the Coal Creek Utility District lying within the corporate boundaries of the City of Bellevue as provided in that certain Settlement Agreement between the City of Bellevue and Coal Creek Utility District, filed under Clerk's Receiving No. 30668.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days after passage and legal publication.
